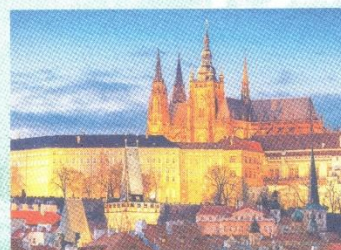


PILGRIMAGE TO MEDJUGORJE, CROATIA, HUNGARY, SLOVAKIA & POLAND

Under spiritual leadership of Fr. Waldemar Podlasz, Pastor
Divine Infant Church in Ottawa-Orleans

Sept. 20 – Oct. 1, 2024 - 12 days - \$4,790.00 (Ottawa/Montreal Dep. incl. all taxes & tips)



- Sep. 20 Afternoon departure from Ottawa or Montreal to Split.
- Sep. 21 Afternoon arrival in Split. We are transfer by bus to Medjugorje. Time for rest, Mass, dinner and overnight.
- Sep. 22 Full day in Medjugorje. Time to visit Apparition Mountain, the Stations of the Cross and pray at "Blue Cross", a place of great healings and graces. Mass, time for individual prayer, dinner and overnight.
- Sep. 23 Another full day in Medjugorje. You may climb the Cross Mountain or have time for individual prayer. For those interested an optional trip to Mostar, a picturesque Bosnian town famous for its 16th century bridge. We also visit the impressive Kravica waterfalls (optional) before returning to Medjugorje for dinner and overnight.
- Sep. 24 This morning we travel to Zagreb, the capital city of Croatia. Upon arrival our tour of Zagreb takes us to the 1000-year old Gornji grad (Upper Town) with the Presidential Palace, the iconic St Mark's Church, the Croatian parliament (Sabor) and the 19th century Dolnji grad (Lower Town). Dinner and overnight.
- Sep. 25 After breakfast we travel to Budapest, the capital of Hungary. En route we visit a magnificent monastery in Tihany on Balaton Lake. Upon arrival in Budapest dinner and overnight.
- Sep. 26 Our tour of Budapest includes views of the 13th century Matthias Church, the Citadel on Mt. Gellert, the Royal Castle, the Parliament, Hero's Square and the St. Stephen Basilica. Evening dinner cruise on the river Danube. Dinner and overnight.
- Sep. 27 Today we travel to Zakopane, Poland's "winter capital". We cross through Slovakia, a picturesque mountainous country of Central Europe. En route we stop in Banska Bystrica for Mass and some free time. Continue to Zakopane for dinner and overtime.
- Sep. 28 Zakopane is a lively resort and the best-known mountainous town surrounded by Tatra mountains. Our tour of the resort includes walk along famous Krupowki Street with views of wooden houses and churches in Zakopane's architecture style. After Mass we travel to the world-famous salt mines in Wieliczka. Continue to Krakow for dinner and overnight.
- Sep. 29 This morning we travel to Czestochowa – the site of Poland's greatest shrine – Our Lady of Czestochowa, also known as the "Black Madonna", a pilgrimage destination that goes back to the 14th century. We venerate the priceless and miraculous icon. Continue to Auschwitz, the notorious Nazi concentration camp. We visit a cell in which St. Maximilian Kolbe died and also the Martyrdom Museum recalling the horrors of the Holocaust. Return to Krakow for dinner and overnight.
- Sep. 30 This morning we visit Lagiewniki – world known as "Divine Mercy Shrine". This is where St. Faustyna had had numerous visions of Christ, who told her to keep a diary of their encounters, during which he spoke to her of the Divine Mercy. We visit the convent of St. Faustyna, her tomb and relics. After lunch we explore Krakow's Old Town. We visit the Market Square where we hear the silver trumpet of the bugler from the tower of St. Mary's Church. Many of the buildings in the Old Town are over 700 years old and include marvels such as the Town Hall Tower, the Cloth Hall and most of all the Wawel Royal Castle. Some free time for leisure before returning to hotel for dinner and overnight.
- Oct. 01 Today we are transferred to the airport for a flight to Montreal or Ottawa. Evening arrival.

COST \$4,790.00 INCLUDES:

NOT INCLUDED IN THE COST OF THE TOUR:

- meals not specified, insurance, documentation
- any optional tours (Mostar/waterfalls)

HOW TO BOOK:

Please call, book online or send the registration form printed below. A non-refundable deposit of \$300.00 per person is required at time of booking. Insurance must be purchased at time of booking.

BALANCE OF PAYMENT:

Final balance due is payable 60 days prior to departure. For late bookings (within 60 days) full payment is due immediately.

CANCELLATION:

If cancellation is necessary, please advise IHT immediately in writing. Cancellation charges are as follows:

- 60 days before departure or earlier - \$300.00 per person
- between 60 and 30 days before departure – 50% of the total cost
- 30 days or less – 100% of the total cost

IF YOU CHANGE YOUR BOOKING:

A \$150.00 administration charge will be applied for changes you make to your booking outside the 60 days to departure period. Please note that name changes are not allowed and such will be treated as cancellations.

IF IHT CHANGES YOUR BOOKING:

IHT will advise you of any change we feel significantly alters the holiday which you have purchased from us. Occasionally, changes might occur close to departure time. In such cases, you will be notified as soon as possible. Due to circumstances beyond our control, the local tour operator may have to make last minute changes in hotel or schedule. We reserve the right to substitute any of the hotels with hotels in similar or better category. First class twin-bedded rooms with private facilities are used.

UNUSED SERVICES:

No refund or adjustment can be made for any portion of holiday not used.

GOOD VALUE AND EXPECTATIONS:

The Ministry of Consumer Relations requires that Ontarians traveling abroad be advised that they may encounter different living standards and practices than those at home.

FLIGHT CONNECTIONS:

IHT sells holidays from and returning to Toronto only, unless otherwise specified. In the event of a change in our flight times, with or without notice, we cannot accept responsibility for any special connecting fares which you might purchase and which cannot be changed without penalty.

TRAVEL DOCUMENTATION:

A valid Canadian passport is required for all visits outside of Canada. It is the sole responsibility of the passenger to ensure proper and valid documentation.

Failure to provide valid documentation may result in denied boarding of the aircraft and cancellation of your flight arrangements without refund. If you are holding a passport other than Canadian, please contact IHT to determine whether or not a visa is required for entry into the country you will be visiting.

BAGGAGE ALLOWANCE:

One piece per person (23 kg) plus a carry-on bag (weighing not more than 5 kg)

FLIGHT TIMES:

All flight times are subject to change with or without prior notice to the passengers or his/her agent. IHT does not accept liability for missed connections or any expenses resulting from an off-schedule, rescheduled or late flight operations.

PRICES:

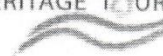
